Sign-Up for Free Pre-K!

Pre-Kindergarten is a program that helps 4 year olds get ready for school. Public Schools have FREE programs. Children have fun learning about shapes, colors, numbers and how to make friends.

Pre-K is good for every child!

Attending Pre-K can help your child:

- have stronger reading, writing, math and English skills
- learn to listen and follow directions
- be social and able to interact with other kids
- to graduate from high school
- have better job opportunities as an adult

If your child is at least 4* years old by September 1st of the school year and meets ANY of the criteria below, then YES, your child would qualify for free public school Pre-K:

- Children from a low income household
- Children unable to speak English well
- Children who are homeless, in foster care, or a child of a member of the U.S. armed forces
- Children with no documentation of U.S. citizenship are still accepted!

**Some districts begin PreK classes for children at ages 3 and 4.*
